Primary Runoff Elections

This legislation would move Pennsylvania to a majority voting system for primary elections.

If no candidate wins an outright majority, a runoff election will be held between the two candidates who received the most votes.

Offices impacted by this law:

- Governor
- Attorney General
- Auditor General
- Treasurer
- State Legislators
- U.S. Representatives
- U.S. Senators.

The runoff shall be held on the fourth Tuesday after the primary election, unless another day is selected by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court.

This act shall take effect in the year 2028.
