BILL NO.	TITLE of BILL	ACTION
SENATE 1	Student Access to The Internet (Education) The bill requires a district school board to provide and adopt an Internet safety policy for student access to the Internet provided by the school district.	
SENATE 2	Year-Round Schooling (Education) This bill will establish a year-round school pilot program for a period of 4 years in order to help the Department of Education make decisions regarding instituting year-round school programs for elementary and secondary schools.	
SENATE 3	Preservation of Historic Sites (State Government) This bill would prevent the removal of public monuments except as specifically approved by an act of the General Assembly.	
SENATE 4	Primary Runoff Elections (State Government) This legislation would move Pennsylvania to a majority voting system for primary elections.	
SENATE 5	Parental Consent to Join Online Social Networks (Law and Justice) This bill prohibits those under the age of eighteen (18) years of age from joining Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, or any other online social network without parental consent.	
SENATE 6	Abolishing Death Penalty (Law and Justice) This bill will eliminate the death penalty in most cases.	
SENATE 7	Municipal Clean and Renewable Energy Act (Environmental Resources) This bill would mandate that municipalities ensure that homes, apartments, and business parks that reside within their jurisdiction are only powered by wind or solar energy by the year 2030.	
SENATE 8	Plastic Grocery Bag Act (Environmental Resources) An act providing a 25-cent tax on all plastic grocery bags.	
SENATE 9	Mileage-Based User Fee (Transportation) This bill will require the State Department of Transportation to impose either a mileage-based fee or an annual fee that would apply to Pennsylvania drivers of plug-in hybrid vehicles and electric vehicles.	
SENATE 10	Ban Cell Phone While Driving (Transportation) This bill will prohibit the use of a hand-held cellular phone while operating a motor vehicle that is in motion upon a public roadway.
